As you'll recall the Board of Directors voted to approve ACHD sponsoring legislation for the 2016 Legislative Session to authorize all Healthcare Districts to utilize the design-build process for construction projects. ACHD's Advocacy Team is in the process of drafting legislative language and will begin meeting with potential Legislators to determine an author.

We are asking each Director for their District's support on this legislative proposal in preparation for the bill to be introduced early next year. Please use the attached Legislative Proposal Analysis as a guide for your Board meetings.

Additionally, it will be critical for the Advocacy Team to have in place a list of projects that can be used to demonstrate the need for this legislation. # Proposal:

Authorize all Healthcare Districts to utilize the design-build process for construction projects.

## Current Law:

- The Local Agency Public Construction Act requires local officials to invite bids for construction projects and then award contracts to the lowest responsible bidder.
- The Public Contracts Code does provide authorization for the use of the design-build process for cities, counties, school districts and specified special districts.
- Sections 32132.5-32132.8 of the Health and Safety Code authorize 4 Healthcare Districts to utilize the design-build process: Sonoma Valley Health Care District, Marin Healthcare District, Last Frontier Healthcare District and Mayers Memorial Hospital District.

# **Background:**

Under the design-build method, a single contract covers the design and construction of a project with a single company or consortium that acts as both the project designer and builder. The design-build entity arranges all architectural, engineering, and construction services, and is responsible for delivering the project at a guaranteed price and schedule based upon performance criteria set by the public agency. The design-build method can be faster (and therefore, cheaper) than the design-build method.

The traditional design-bid-build project approach requires: the separate selection of the design consultant or contractor; completion of design; advertising for bids; and selection of the construction contractor. Typically, design-bid-build projects incur many delays, costly change orders and longer OSHPD review times resulting in increased costs. Design-build avoids those problems due to the overlap of design and construction activities, thereby resulting in additional time savings and lower project costs.

ACHD sponsored unsuccessful legislation in 2009 and 2010 to grant design-build authority to all District Hospitals. Given the success of recent legislation granting 3 additional District Hospitals this authority, there seems to be a shift in the political mind-set about design-build.

Legislation passed in 2013, SB 785 (Wolk), amended Government Code relating to the design-build procurement processes already in law and extends the sunset date for such authorization until 2025.

ACHD has heard from the following Districts that would use the design-build process with this legislation: Tri-City Healthcare District, Peninsula Health Care District, John C. Fremont Healthcare District, and Tahoe Forest Hospital District.

## **Potential Opposition:**

ACHD's sponsored legislation faced opposition from Professional Engineers in California Government and other public unions, including AFSCME in 2009 and 2010. However, most recent measures granting 3 Healthcare Districts design-build authority have garnered no opposition.
